Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels delivers healthy, prepared meals to the homes of seniors who would likely have to move to a senior care facility because they're unable to cook for themselves and are at risk of malnutrition. The program is available throughout the state and administered through its Area Agencies on Aging.
