Food Assistance Programs for Seniors

Good nutrition is important for seniors. However, many older adults either struggle to shop and cook for themselves due to limited mobility or lack the financial resources to keep a well-stocked pantry. The following organizations can help seniors maintain a healthy diet by providing meal deliveries or reducing the financial burden of grocery shopping.

Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels is a national organization that combats both hunger and isolation. Local Meals on Wheels organizations deliver freshly prepared meals to seniors each day, helping ensure they meet their day-to-day nutritional requirements. The volunteer drivers also provide wellness checks and give seniors some regular social contact, helping them feel confident and safe while they live independently in the community.

In addition to these Meals on Wheels organizations, many local senior centers offer a congregate nutrition service. Seniors can contact their nearest senior center for information about meal service times and prices.
