## Meals on Wheels

The Meals on Wheels program has provided balanced, nutritious meals to those in need since the 1960s. This service is generally available to seniors over the age of 60 who are homebound or have a medical condition that makes it difficult to prepare meals. It's important to note that each Meals on Wheels provider determines the frequency and schedule of meal deliveries. Some locations may also have a maximum time frame or number of meals it can deliver to an individual.
